GOSPEL MESSAGE

As we joyfully celebrate the feast of the Holy Trinity, the Bible assures us that God exists as the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, three Persons, remaining one God. This is a Divine Revelation, not a human discovery. There is no logical explanation of this mystery. God is incomprehensible to our imagination. “We walk by faith” and “not by sight”, fixing our eyes on what is eternal. “For what can be seen is temporary, but what cannot be seen is eternal.” (2 Cor. 4:14-ff).

The Solemnity of - The Most Holy Trinity

As Catholics we have rituals that we do so often, one being the way we begin and end all prayers: *In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit!* It is one of the first religious acts we teach our children. We invoke the Holy Trinity (Three Persons in One God), and we bless ourselves with the sign of the cross the sign of God’s eternal love for us! The Sign of the Cross is an affirmation of our faith. Whether morning / evening prayer, Mass, Rosary, or grace before dinner, we always begin and end with this Trinitarian blessing. It defines who we are, to whom we belong. We are people God loves, forgives and empowers!

Today is a feast to celebrate our God, and the intimate relationship between Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We have a Father who loves us unconditionally, and his Son who made this love concrete by becoming one of us and dying for us and bringing us God’s forgiveness, and we have the Holy Spirit, who is God dwelling within us, empowering us. The three divine persons work together for the salvation of all. So too must we work together for the good of all. May everything we do and say, be guided by the Holy Trinity.
