Blood and Sacrifice

Sacrificial blood of the new covenant poured out for us! We do not often think of taking part in these events for our salvation, yet Jesus our Messiah takes up the covenant of Moses, renews and fulfills it for us on his cross. He changes things, once and for all, so we can, here and now, take part in his work, opening divine grace and life to the world. The Eucharist draws us into the work of his cross, his life giving service.

Catechism of the Catholic Church (# 271)

What is the Eucharist? - The Eucharist is the sacrifice of Body and Blood of the Lord Jesus which he instituted to perpetuate the sacrifice of the cross throughout the ages until his return in glory. Thus he entrusted to his Church this memorial of his death and resurrection.

TWELVE PROMISES MADE TO ST. MARGARET MARY ALACOQUE BY JESUS FOR THOSE DEDICATED TO HIS SACRED HEART:

I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.

I will establish peace in their families

I will console them in all their troubles

They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of their death.

I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings

Sinners shall find in My Heart the source of an infinite ocean of mercy

Tepid souls shall become fervent

Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection

I will bless the homes where an image of My Heart shall be exposed and honoured

*I will give to priests the power of touching the most hardened hearts
Those who propagate this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be effaced*

The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the First Friday of nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under my displeasure, nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Heart shall be their assured refuge at that last hour.

“Look at this Heart which has loved men so much, and yet men do not want to love Me in return. Through you My divine Heart wishes to spread its love everywhere on earth.”

Corpus Christi - 2 Giugno

La solennità del *Corpus Domini* (espressione latina che significa *Corpo del Signore*), più propriamente chiamata **solennità del santissimo Corpo e Sangue di Cristo**, è una delle principali solennità dell'anno liturgico della Chiesa cattolica. Si celebra il giovedì successivo alla solennità della Santissima Trinità.

Storia

Venne istituita l'8 settembre 1264 da papa Urbano IV con la Bolla *Transiturus de hoc mundo* in seguito al miracolo di Bolsena. Il suo scopo era quello di celebrare la reale presenza di Cristo nell'Eucaristia.

Durante il periodo delle guerre di religione in Francia (tra il 1540 e il 1600), la processione del Corpus Domini fu un'occasione di gravi perturbazioni della pace.

Infatti per i Calvinisti (eretici noti in Francia come Ugonotti) la transustanziazione è una leggenda priva di fondamento e facevano la processione oggetto di numerose provocazioni, e veri e propri attacchi alle immagini e all'ostia, oppure semplicemente dimostravano la loro diversità religiosa (non stendendo alla finestra le tovaglie che, tradizionalmente, le famiglie cattoliche francesi mettevano in mostra in omaggio alla processione). Sovente inoltre le folle cattoliche si radunavano per la processione e poi attaccavano i protestanti in massa, oppure chiedevano il perdono e la benedizione ecclesiastica per le violenze che avevano perpetrato nei giorni precedenti proprio in occasione del Corpus Domini.

Fino alla metà del '600 in certe zone della Francia la processione del Corpus Domini fu quindi accompagnata da massicci schieramenti di forza pubblica, e con i fedeli in genere armati e pronti a difendere l'ostia da eventuali profanazioni.
