**WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY
January 18-25, 2026**

For this year, 2026, the prayers and reflections for the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity were prepared by the Inter-Church Relations' Department of the Armenian Apostolic Church. The first Christian Ecumenical Council was held in Nicaea, near Constantinople in 325 AD. This commemoration provides a unique opportunity to reflect on and celebrate the common faith of Christians, as expressed in the Creed formulated during this Council; a faith that remains alive and fruitful in our days. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity 2026 offers an invitation to draw on this shared heritage and to enter more deeply into the faith that unites all Christians.

During this week we will touch on reflections about the history of Christian denominations. The core and fundamental teaching of Christianity is: one God in three persons...the Trinity... and proclaim Jesus Christ as perfect divine and perfect human. Jesus Christ is our Revealer and our Redeemer. All Christian denominations believe in one Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church.
