FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT LAETARE SUNDAY

Today is the halfway mark of the Sundays of Lent; Easter is enticingly near. This Sunday is known as *Laetare Sunday* for the first word of the Introit or Entrance Antiphon, *Laetare* (rejoice); it is a Sunday of joy, our foretaste of Easter joy. The celebrant has the option to wear rose-coloured vestments. This is also the Second Scrutiny in preparation for the baptism of adults and the Easter vigil.

The First Reading (*Joshua*, 5:9,10-12) recounts the celebration of the Passover in the Promised Land by Joshua and those who had sojourned with him in the desert for 40 years.

The Second Reading (Cor., 5:17-21) The reconciliation of mankind with God has been brought about by Christ's death on the cross. Jesus, who is like men in all things "yet without sinning" bore the sins of men and offered himself on the cross as an atoning sacrifice for all those sins, thereby reconciling men to God; through this sacrifice we became the righteousness of God.

LENTEN FRIDAYS - Days of Abstinence - No Meat

In Canada, by decree of the Canadian Bishops, first preference is abstaining from meat but "on Fridays it is permitted to substitute abstinence or fasting with other forms of penance, especially works of charity." (c.1253

La parabola del vangelo odierno mette di fronte tre protagonisti che potrebbero contendersi il titolo del brano: il padre misericordioso, il figlio prodigo, il figlio maggiore. Forse impropriamente è stata chiamata come «parabola del figlio prodigo»; in realtà il primo prodigo è il padre, talmente «prodigo nell'amore» da scandalizzare il figlio maggiore.

In Gesù che accoglie i peccatori, gli stranieri, le donne di strada, gli esclusi, in Gesù che siede a mensa con gente disprezzata e impura si manifesta un Dio che a tutti offre la sua ospitalità, il suo perdono e la capacità di rinnovarsi perché sono da lui amati. Se nella parabola c'è un rimprovero, esso è rivolto al primogenito e a chi come lui pensa che l'osservanza esteriore della legge sia fonte di merito e autorizzi il disprezzo nei confronti dei fratelli peccatori. Il peccato sta anche nel servire «con l'animo del mercenario» (B. Maggioni), nel rimanere in casa senza apprezzarne il dono, nel respingere e condannare senza appello il fratello che ha sbagliato.
